12 Signs Your Loved One May Need Care:

- 1. Increased falls or risk of falls**
- 2. Wandering from home or getting lost**
- 3. EMS has been called to the home more than once**
- 4. Unable to self-administer medication or multiple expired medications**
- 5. Normally outgoing, has become withdrawn or secretive**
- 6. Difficulty with one or more activities of daily living such as bathing, preparing meals, using the bathroom...**
- 7. Unsanitary or unsafe living conditions**
- 8. Repeating questions or making multiple phone calls asking the same questions**
- 9. Confusion, agitation, unfounded accusations or suspiciousness**
- 10. Diagnosis of dehydration or malnutrition**
- 11. Unsafe behavior (leaving the stove on, exterior doors open)**
- 12. Deterioration of personal hygiene**

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
